

THE WILDFIRE CRISIS STRATEGY

INITIAL LANDSCAPE INVESTMENTS

At the Forest Service, we announced plans to invest \$131 million to begin implementation within high-risk fireheds in support of the strategy, "Confronting the Wildfire Crisis: A Strategy for Protecting Communities and Improving Resilience in America's Forests." The initial investment in 10 landscapes across Washington, Oregon, California, Idaho, Montana, Colorado, New Mexico, and Arizona will lead to about 208,000 acres of wildfire risk reduction treatments this fiscal year and will contribute significantly to increased resilience in the years to come.

We will work with other Federal agencies, including the U.S. Department of the Interior's, and with Tribes, States, local communities, private landowners, and partners to treat entire areas across all jurisdictions. The 10-year strategy calls for treating up to 20 million acres on national forests and grasslands and supporting treatment of up to 30 million acres of other Federal, State, Tribal, and private lands.

Many high-risk fireheds remain to be treated beyond those captured in this initial round of landscapes. Alongside partners, we will be working to identify additional landscapes in the coming years. We will make additional information on these landscapes and projects, as well as follow on announcements, available throughout the year.

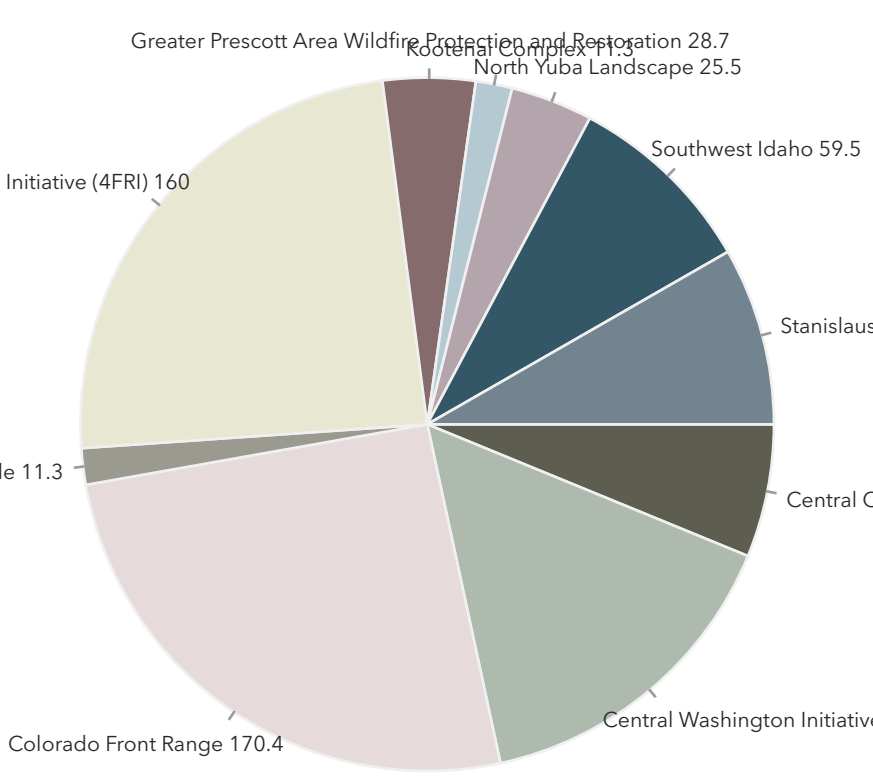
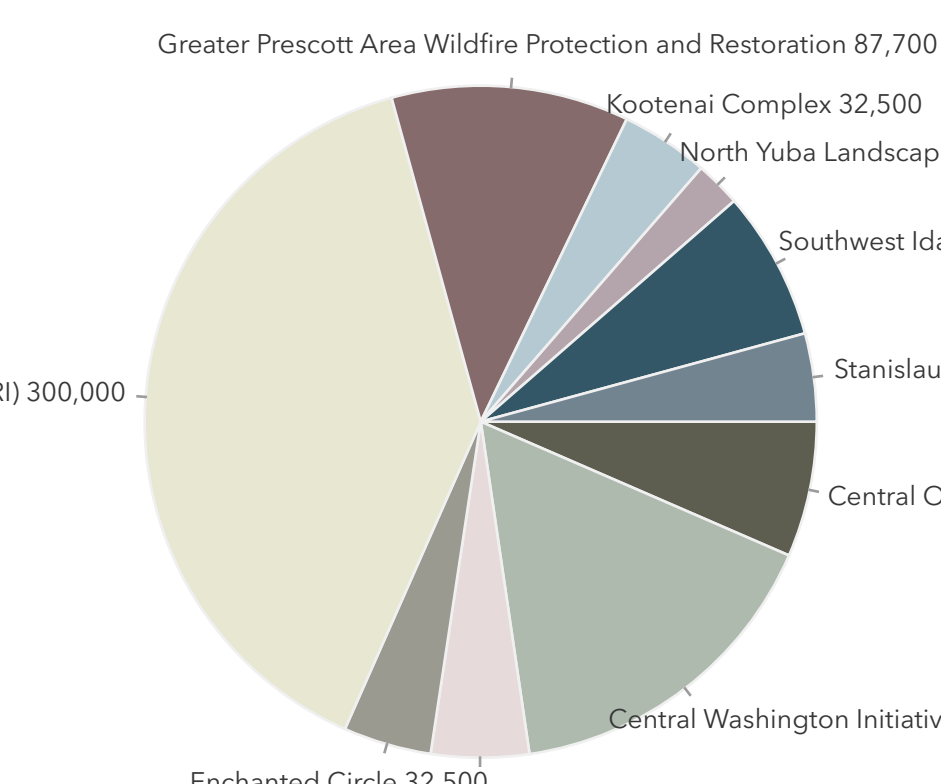
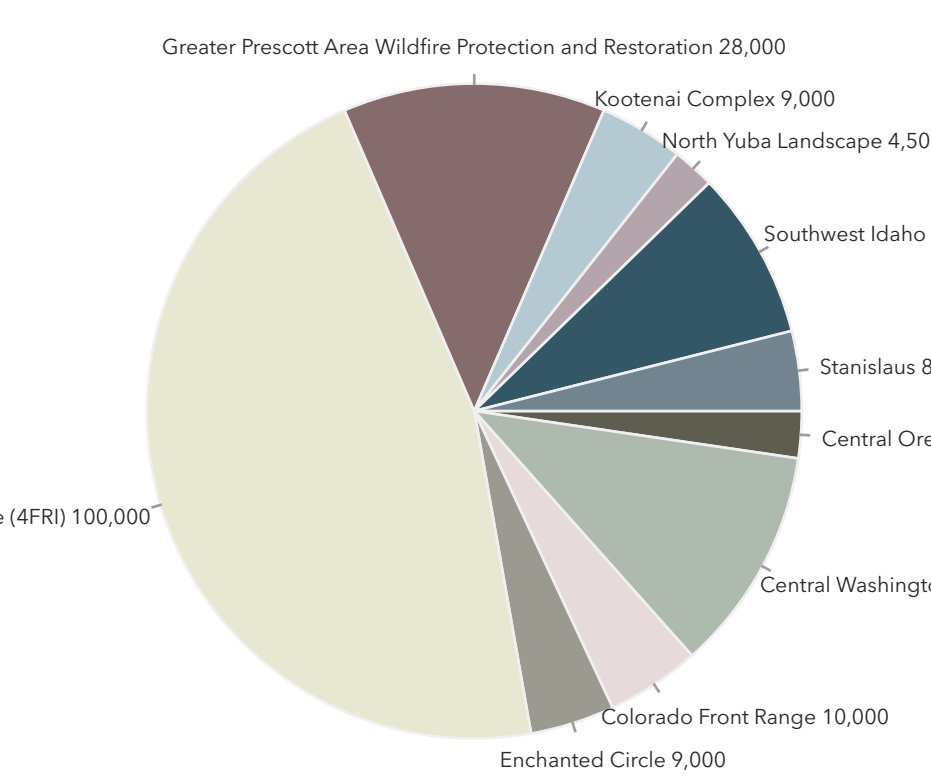
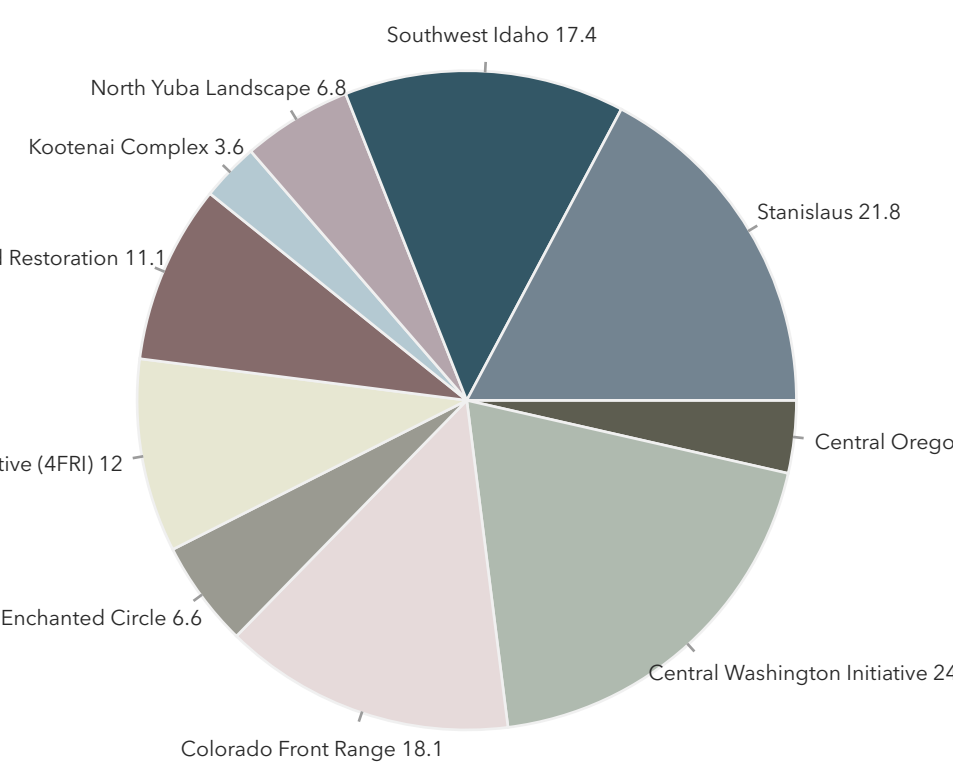


BIL Landscape Investment for FY2022

Acres Planned to be Accomplished in FY 2022-2024

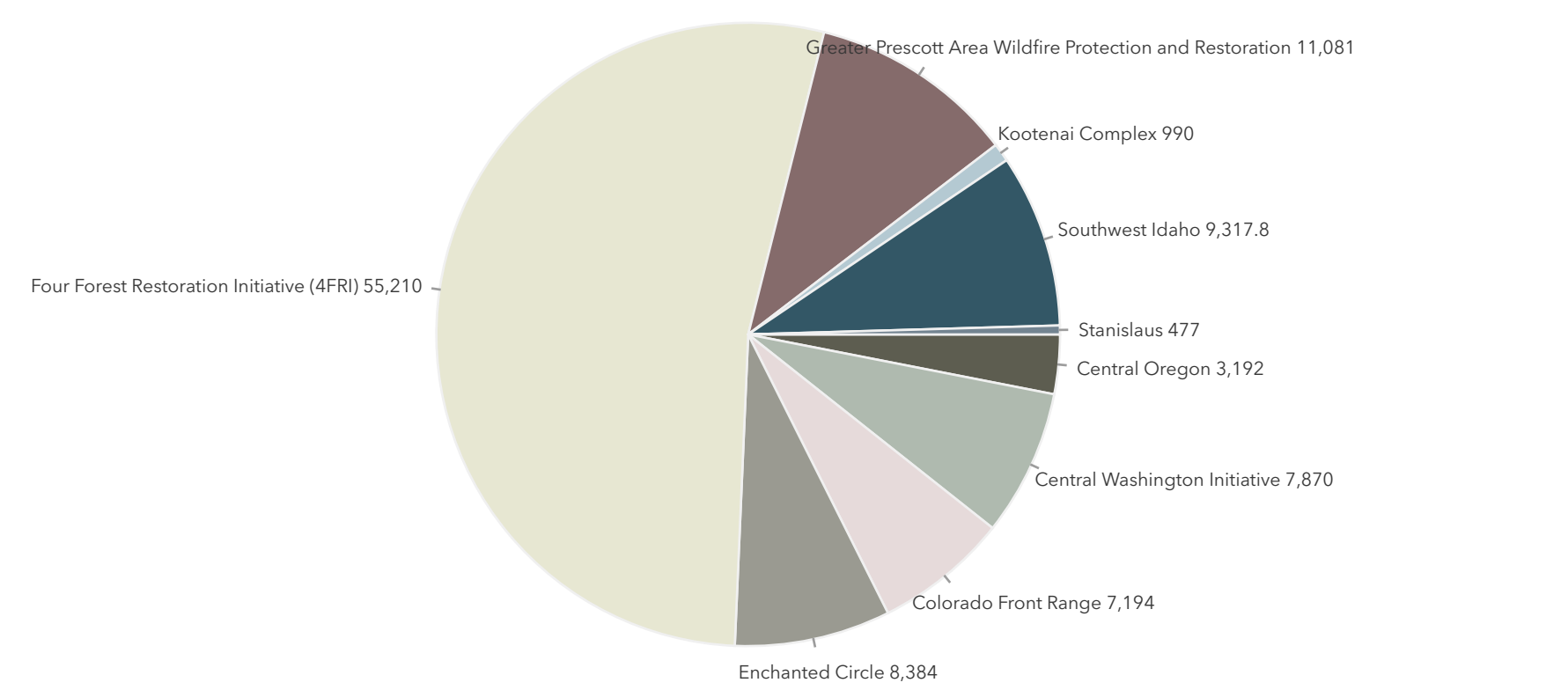
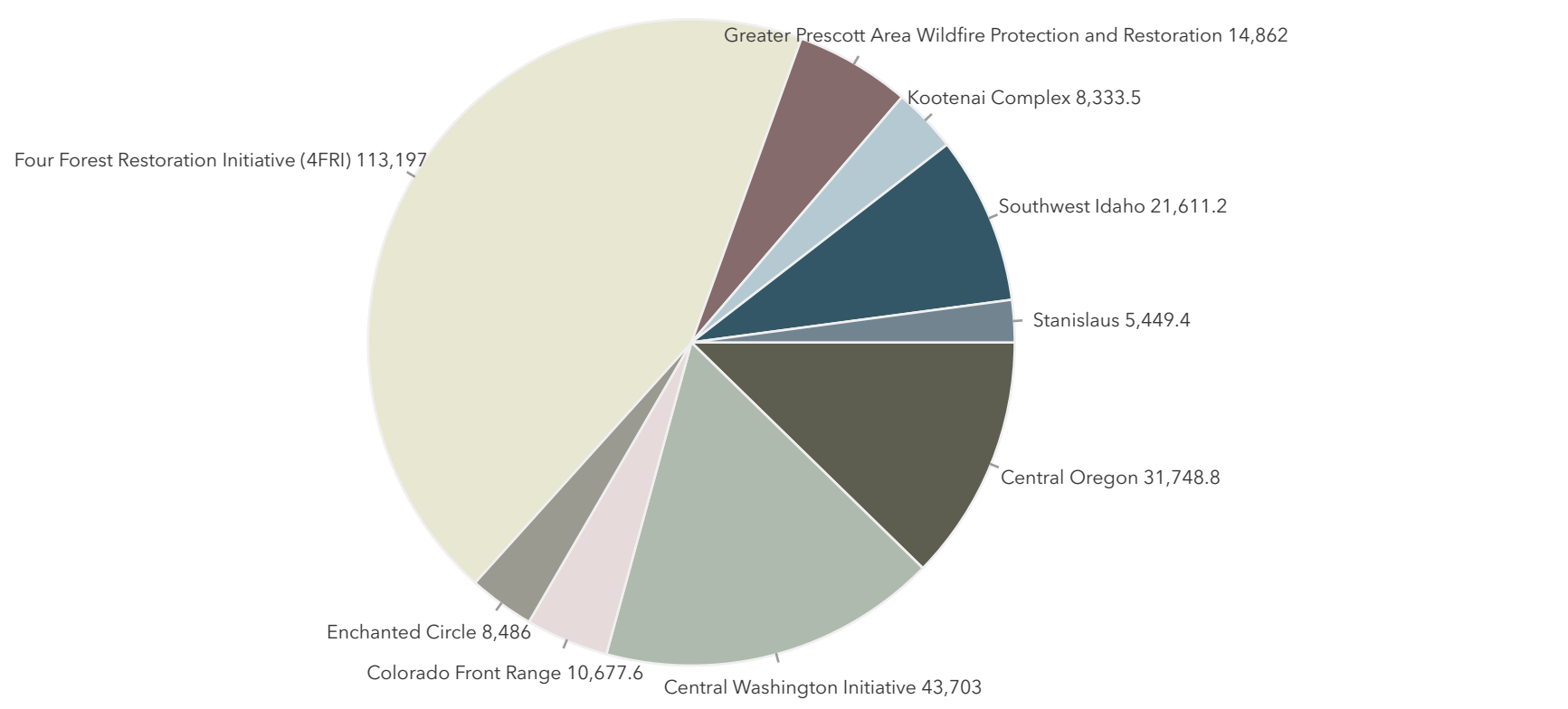

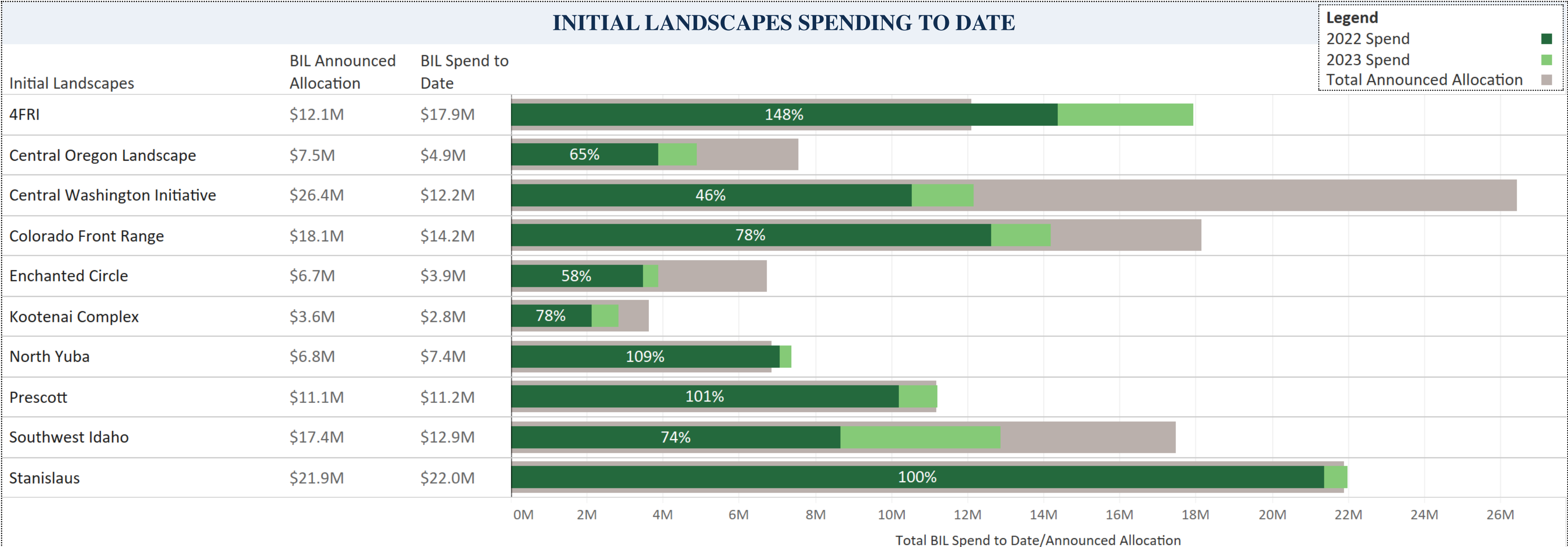
